It is not necessary to submit a paper application in order to qualify for the program.

Eligibility Guidelines

To apply for a 2008 Award, you MUST:

- Be a full-time undergraduate who will be returning to college for the Spring 2009 term
- Have a minimum 2.50 cumulative grade-point average (GPA) on a 4.00 scale
- Attain the minimum required points in PART I, Section A (Fraternity Leadership)

Monday, October 6th, 2008.

Your official transcript **MUST** be postmarked by
Thursday, November 3rd, 2008
